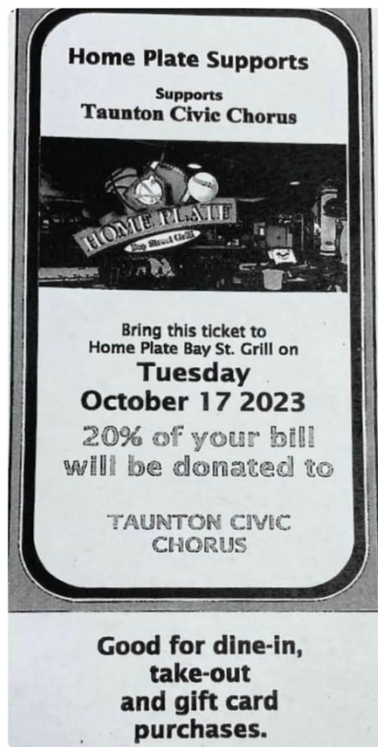

Debbie Garnett was listening to and singing music at a young age.

"As a kid, we always had WBZ on the radio. It was pop hits, and my sister and I used to harmonize together."

As for Anne Alexander, she was Daddy's little girl, so whatever her Dad liked, she liked. While her friends were into the Beatles, she was listening to Count Basie, Sarah Vaughn and Billy Eckstine.

"My father was a jazz aficionado...I went to many local concerts and local gigs of his friends while I was in grammar school. We saw Dave Brubeck in Boston, Dave McKenna and Dick Johnson on the Cape."

Garnett and Alexander are TCC's newest leaders. They both have been on the Chorus Board of Directors, but now share the title of Co-President. They assume the position after the retirement of Barbara Quill who held the position for 7 years.

Alexander joined TCC 14 years ago after her retirement from teaching elementary school. That was back when the Chorus was a small group of members who had been together for years – present members Mac Anslow, Dick Shafer, and Martin Berry among them.

Going forward, as TCC approaches its 65th Birthday, the co-Presidents have a vision for the future.

Garnett sees, "More singers of all ages, and more recognition" from the community.

Alexander builds on that idea. "I hope to continue with the changes we've made in the past few years. Of course, fundraising, name recognition, community events, and scholarships will remain high on my list."

What are their favorite things about TCC?

Alexander says it's the members who are "a great group to plan and spend time with, the talented and enthusiastic music director and accompanist, and the engaged and hands-on Board of Directors.

Garnett believes, "Hearing the voices mix is magical!"
